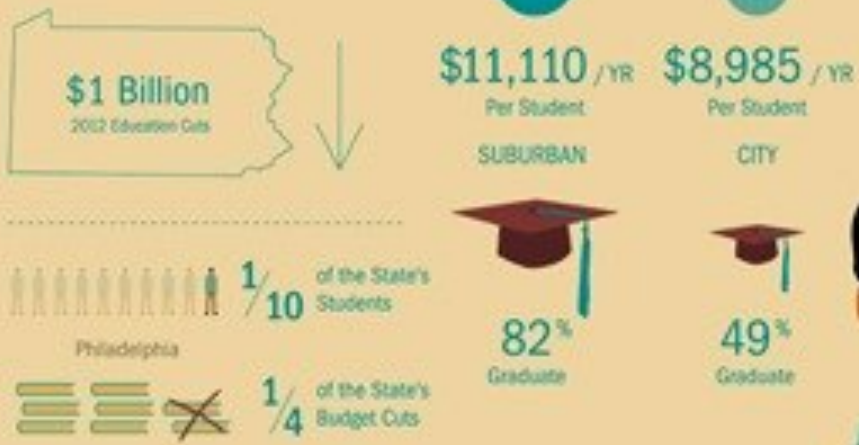

PA is ranked 43rd of 50 in educational funding equality among income levels.

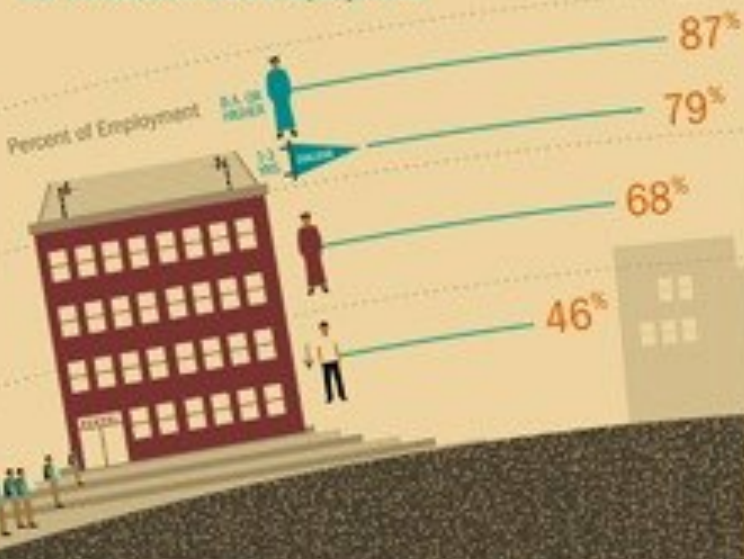
PA is one of the worst funders of education, second only to Nebraska.

US Education and Employment



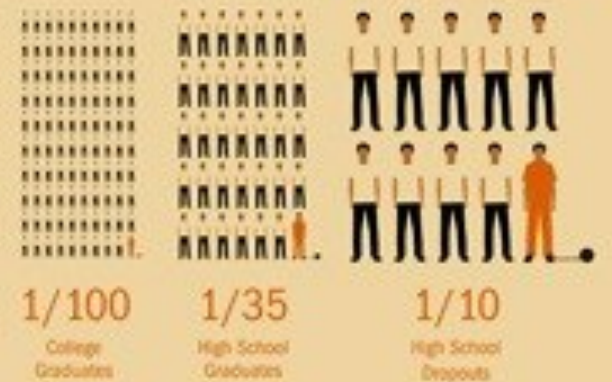
